I have tried to copy the census as recorded, where errors occur, I apologize. Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.

Joel (Joe) S. Harris married Lillie Jones. Both were born in North Carolina.
