I have tried to copy the census as recorded, where errors occur, I apologize. Death certificates are not available for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.

Excerpts from the Obituary of William M. Murray published Friday, May 1, 1931; "Funeral services for William M. Murray, 82, who died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. R.B. Puckett at <u>Glendale</u> Thursday morning, will be conducted at the <u>Glendale Wesleyan Church</u> Friday afternoon. Interment will follow in the <u>Glendale Community Cemetery</u>. Mr. Murray was one of the oldest residents of <u>Glendale</u> and always took an active part in his church work.

No records of Margaret Murray's death or interment were found.


