Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.

The Family of <u>Virginia Rothrock Oxner</u>, daughter of William T. & Pauline Rothrock; Virginia Rothrock married John Elmer Oxner. They lived in their own home on the Glendale/ Whitestone Road.

Virginia taught in the <u>Glendale Elementary School</u> for a number of years while Elmer worked in <u>Glendale Mills</u>.

Obituary records show that; <u>Virginia Rothrock Oxner</u> died at the age of 89 in November, 1998. John Elmer Oxner died at the age of 94 in March, 2002.

The Family of George Brunson Rothrock, son of William T. and Pauline Rothrock; George B. Rothrock married Gladys White, daughter of Bernard and Winnie White. George was a Funeral Director and Gladys was a weaver in <u>Glendale Mills</u>.

George B. Rothrock died at the age of 96 in December, 2009.

Gladys W. Rothrock died at the age of 70 in October, 1985.

They were living in Ware Shoals, S. C. where George was a partner in a Mortuary when they died.

Ella Mae Quinn Rothrock died at the age of 81 in October, 1995.

David Benton Rothrock died at the age of 83 in May, 2011.

Reba Deaton Rothrock lives today in their home of the Glendale/Whitestone Road.

Not many people in Glendale knew him because he joined the Navy and was gone most of the time the family lived here. He was born about December, 1921. He retired from the Navy and lived in Lyman, S. C. until his death in February, 1998.

Mr. Rothrock farmed and raised cattle .The family home was a large two story house located on his farm on the Glendale/Whitestone road.
