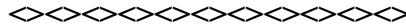


Glendale's Freeman Families

Census Enumerators listed names and dates as they understood the registrant who oft times had little or no education which led to numerous errors in names, dates and ages. I have tried to copy the census as recorded, where errors occur, I apologize. Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.



The Family of John B. and Clara Freeman;

The 1940 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

John B. Freeman 68, husband

Wife; Clara 59

Son; Troy 28, cloth room/mill store

Obituary records show that;

John B. Freeman died in November, 1944.

Clara McBride Freeman died at the age of 96 in Inman, S. C. in April, 1977.

Troy Freeman died at the age of 94 in September, 1995.



The Family of C. W. and Annie M. Freeman;

The 1940 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

C.W. Freeman 45, husband/auto parts supervisor

Wife; Annie M. 38, weaver

Children; Lamar 18, battery filler

Gwendolyn 16, soil commission

Clifford 13

Francis P. 11

Obituary records show that;

C.W. Freeman died at the age of 63 in Valley Falls, S. C. in July, 1960.

Annie Mae Price Freeman died at the age of 71 in Valley Falls, S.C. in December, 1971

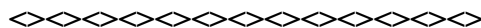
