## Glendale's Gault Families

Census Enumerators listed names and dates as they understood the registrant who oft times had little or no education which led to numerous errors in names, dates and ages. I have tried to copy the census as recorded, where errors occur, I apologize. Death certificates are not available in Spartanburg for years before 1917 and Obituaries have not been put on microfilm for the years 1924 through 1929.



The Family of Rev. Sidney and Harriette Burgess Gault;

The 1880 Union County/Gouldeysville Census listed the household as;

S.D.F. Gault 28, husband/farmer/born in N.C. Wife; Harriette 24

Children; Edna 6 W. Lester 5 Alonzo 2

The 1910 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

Harriet Gault 54, head of household/widow/mother of 8 children

Children; Forney 22 Sidney 15 Coke 18

Roland W. Holt 28

Rev. S.D. F Gault is buried in the Glendale Community Cemetery;

Grave marker; Rev. S.D. F. Gault, May 22, 1852=September 13, 189-(unreadable)

No record of Harriette Burgess Gault status was found.

The Family of Edna Gault Davis, daughter of Rev. Sidney and Harriette Gault;

Edna Gault married Augustus L. Davis from North Carolina.

<u>The 1900</u> Spartanburg Township Census showed they had been married 6 years and were the parents of 3 children. The household was listed as:

Augustus L. Davis 27, husband/slubbers/born September, 1872

Wife; Edna 26, born June 1873

Children; Annie 5, born April, 1895 Roy 2, born June, 1897

Harold, 4 months, born January, 1900

Boarder; Walter Gault 17, born November, 1883/ weaver

The 1910 Spartanburg/Glendale Census showed that Augustus and Edna had been married

16 years and were the parents of 5 children. The household was listed as;

Children; Annie 15 Roy 13 Harold 10 Pierce 7 Humbert 4

The 1920 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

Augustus L. Davis, 48, husband/cotton mill Wife; Edna 46

Children; Roy 22, cotton mill William P. 17, card room Humbert D. 13

Fay 9 Frank E. 6

The 1940 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

A.L. Davis 68, cotton mill Wife; Edna 66

Children; Humbert 33, card tender Fay 26, spinner

Pierce Gault, son of Sidney and Harriette Burgess Gaut;

The 1940 Census records show that he was a 75 year old patient in the Spartanburg County Home.

No other records were found.

Pierce Davis is buried in the Glendale Community Cemetery.

Rev. W. Lester Gault, son of Rev. Sidney and Harriette Burgess Gault;

The 1900 Spartanburg Township Census showed he was living with his sister, Edna and her husband, Augustus L. Davis.

The Family of Mae Gault Holt Hellams, daughter of Rev. Sidney and Harriette Gault; Mae Gault first married Roland W. Holt and they became the parents of one son, Raymond Holt. For picture and family story; click Raymond Holt-Glendale Mill Supervisors.

Roland W. Holt died and is buried in the Glendale Community Cemetery.

Grave Marker; R. W. Holt, September 16, 1881=August 16, 1907

The 1920 Spartanburg / Glendale Census listed the household as;

May Holt 38, head of household/widow

Son; Raymond 14

Mother; Harriet Gault 66 Brother; Alonzo Gault 40

Following the death of Roland W. Holt, Mae married J. O. Hellams.

The 1940 Spartanburg/Glendale Census listed the household as;

James O. Hellams 58, husband/mill second hand Wife Mae 58

Mae Holt Hellams died and is buried in the Glendale Community Cemetery;

Grave marker; Mae Holt Hellams, 1880=1948

No record of J.O. Hellam's status was found.

The Family of Sidney Gault Ledbetter, daughter of Rev. Sidney and Harriette Gault;

Sidney Gault married Dr. Frank Carver Ledbetter, Physician from North Carolina.

The 1920 Greenville Township Census listed the household as;

Frank C. Ledbetter 30, husband/Physician Wife; Sidney 25

Daughter; Harriett L. 1 month

The 1940 Greenville Township Census listed the household as;

Franklin C. Ledbetter 50, Physician Wife; Sidney 45

Obituary records show that;

Sidney Gault Ledbetter died at the age of 82 in August, 1977.

No record was found regarding the status of Franklin Carver Ledbetter.
